



Online Application Instructions

HOW DO I ACCESS THE APPLICATION SYSTEM?

Click on “Apply Online” in the menu of the American Academy in Berlin’s website to get to the login page.

NEW USER:

If you are a new applicant, please click on the tab “Create new account.” You will be asked to fill out your name, email, and enter a CAPTCHA code. You will then receive an email with a link to confirm your account (if you do not see this email, check your spam folder). The link in the email will bring you back to the online application site, where you can set your password and continue with your application.

RETURNING USER:

If you applied online previously, you may use the same username and password. If you forgot your password, you can retrieve it by clicking the “Request new password” tab on the login page. The first part of your earlier application (name and home address) will be displayed so that you may edit it; however, you will need to fill out the required fields again.

HOW DOES THE ONLINE APPLICATION WORK?

The online application form consists of six steps (see [screenshots](#) below). You do not need to complete the form in one session. It is possible to log out of your application; your information will be saved and you can login again later to complete your application. Required fields are marked with a red asterisk. Once you have gathered the necessary information and prepared your supporting materials, the application should take about 20 minutes to complete.

Before submitting, you have the opportunity to review and revise all fields. Once submitted, however, you can no longer edit your application, except for the account data and home contact address. WHOM DO I LIST AS REFERENCES?

You will need to provide the names and contact information of three references in the online application form. For the Academy’s independent review process, please **ask the individuals you list as references to email us their letters on your behalf by September 29, 2017** to references@americanacademy.de.

References should be familiar with your work, particularly your proposal, and be able to comment on your abilities, as well as career to date. Statements by references to the Academy will be read by the peer reviewers and Selection Committee, but are not released to the applicant.

WHICH MATERIALS WILL I NEED TO UPLOAD?

TITLED PROJECT PROPOSAL

Professors, scholars, journalists, professionals, non-fiction writers, applicants in film: five to seven double-space pages with a description of your scholarly or professional project, a work plan, the form of your project (i.e. book, set of critical essays, professional study).

Fiction writers: a writing sample (15 to 20 pages) from your proposed project.

Note: We welcome projects at all stages of development. Candidates should explain how their projects will benefit from a residency in Berlin, but they do not need to be working on German topics.

Maximum file size: 150 MB. Allowed extensions: *txt, doc, docx, pdf, png, jpg, tiff*.

CURRICULUM VITAE

Abbreviated version of 10-12 pages, including list of major publications and projects.

Maximum file size: 150 MB. Allowed extensions: *txt, doc, docx, pdf, png, jpg, tiff*.

TWO WRITING SAMPLES

Scholars, professionals, writers: recent and representative chapters or articles from published or forthcoming work; suggested limit 60 pages combined.

Filmmakers: You may upload your films to YouTube or Vimeo or any other online service and include the link in the documents you upload as Writing Sample 1 and Writing Sample 2. Alternatively, you can mail two copies in “Region 1” DVD format and two copies in “Region 2” DVD format, labeled with your name and format, to the Berlin Office, address below.

Maximum file size: 150 MB. Allowed extensions: *txt, doc, docx, pdf, png, jpg, tiff*.

CAN I APPLY BY REGULAR MAIL?

Yes, but we strongly encourage applicants to use the online application system. You may download a pdf of the application form, complete the form, and mail it, along with all supporting materials, to:
